Manavari Temple - is the first place where Lord Rama installed and prayed the Siva lingam. At present this lingam at Manavari temple is named as Ramalingam as this lingam was erected by Rama. Sri Lanka Ramayana tour important place.






Day 2 - Chilaw to Anuradhapura

Spanning about 48 kilometers, this natural formation is visible from satellite images and is a site of both historical and geological intrigue. 




Day 4 - Jaffna




Day 5 – Jaffna to Polonnaruwa via Trincomalee

This iconic practice, passed down through generations, not only provides sustenance but also offers a captivating glimpse into the rich cultural heritage of coastal communities like Ahangama.
